Respected Shageer Mohammad Sahib, Qa'id Umoomi, announced Alm-e Inami Winner for 2019 along with names of top 10 positions.

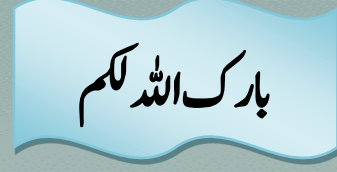
Respected Abdul Jamil Mubbashar Sahib, Sadr Sahib Majlis Ansarullah Australia delivered concluding speech and led silent prayers.

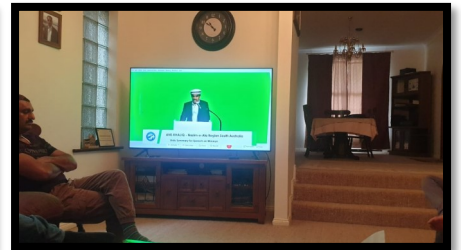

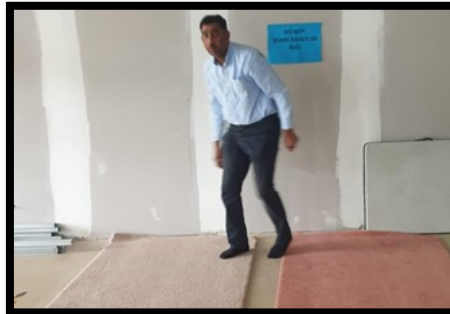
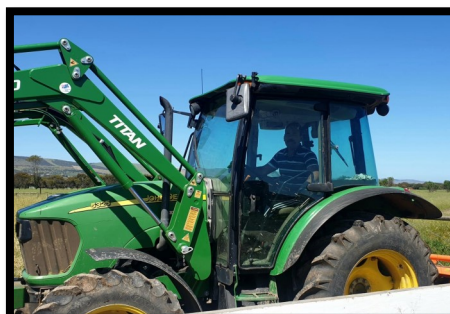

Q60: How can you tell if a man is honorable by his treatment towards women and should women keep an eye out for an honorable man in order to avoid mistreatment?

Islam fourteen centuries ago established women with spiritual equality, gave them civil rights, right to inherit property, approve or reject marriage proposals and right to education.

Women are honored and respected and under no circumstances inferior to men. In one Hadith men have been commanded to treat women just as they would like to be treated: "*give her (your wife) food when you take food, clothe when you clothe yourself, do not revile her face, and do not beat her*". An honorable man is defined by his treatment of women and with the practice of such teachings, women should feel protected in all circumstances. Islamic teachings thus condemn all forms of violence, abuse and ill treatment of women and ensure that they are given the due respect that they are entitled to.
