Majlis Ansarullah holds 2nd National Virtual Talim Rally Saturday-Sunday 17-18 July 2021

Majlis Ansarullah Australia, with the grace of Allah, successfully held its 2nd National Virtual Talim Rally on Saturday and Sunday 17-18 July, 2021. This was a National event in which Ilmi (Academic) competitions i.e. Recitation from the Holy Quran (general category and specific Category, Nazam (Poem) and speech (Urdu & English) were held.

The event was telecasted live via Ansarullah YouTube Channel while participants joined via Zoom Video link.

The Rally was watched by 234 members on Day 1 and 359 on day 2. 64 Ansar participated in the competitions. On Saturday, Respected Abdul Jamil Mubbashar Sahib, Sadr Majlis Ansarullah Australia declared the Rally open after a brief address and led silent prayers. He also addressed the concluding session emphasizing on repentance and seeking forgiveness from Allah Almighty. National Talim Department held its 2nd National Virtual Talim Rally as per instructions from Respected Sadr Sahib Majlis Ansarullah Australia who had earlier constituted 3 members committee to coordinate, organise and hold Talim Rally using present technical online resources with the members participating from their homes. The Committee comprised Ch Nemat Ali, Qa'id Talim, Respected Shageer Mohammad Sahib, Qa'id Umoomi and Respected Saqib Mahmood Atif Sahib, Nazim Ilmi Competitions. The Committee worked tirelessly to successfully hold the Rally under continued guidance from Respected Sadr Sahib Ansarullah Australia. Judges also deserve great appreciation for their continued support and time throughout the Rally.

Rally proceedings were live both days from at 01:30 pm (AEST) and to 04:30 pm. The opening session of the Rally was chaired by Respected Abdul Jamil Mubbashar Sahib Sadr Majlis Ansarullah Australia. The Session started on Saturday 17th July 2021 at 1.30 pm Sydney time with recitation from the Holy Quran followed by an Urdu Nazm. Respected Sadr Sahib Ansarullah delivered a short opening address and led the silent prayers. He then declared the Talim Rally open for competitions. First day, 3 competitions held namely recitation of the Holy Quran (General & Specific category) and Poem. Speech competitions of Urdu and English were held on the second day i.e. 18th July.

At the conclusion of the Rally on Sunday 18th July 2021, Respected Sadr Sahib Majlis Ansarullah chaired the concluding session. Respected Qa'id Sahib Talim presented word of gratitude for the success and Nazim Sahib Ilmi competitions announced the names of the winners. 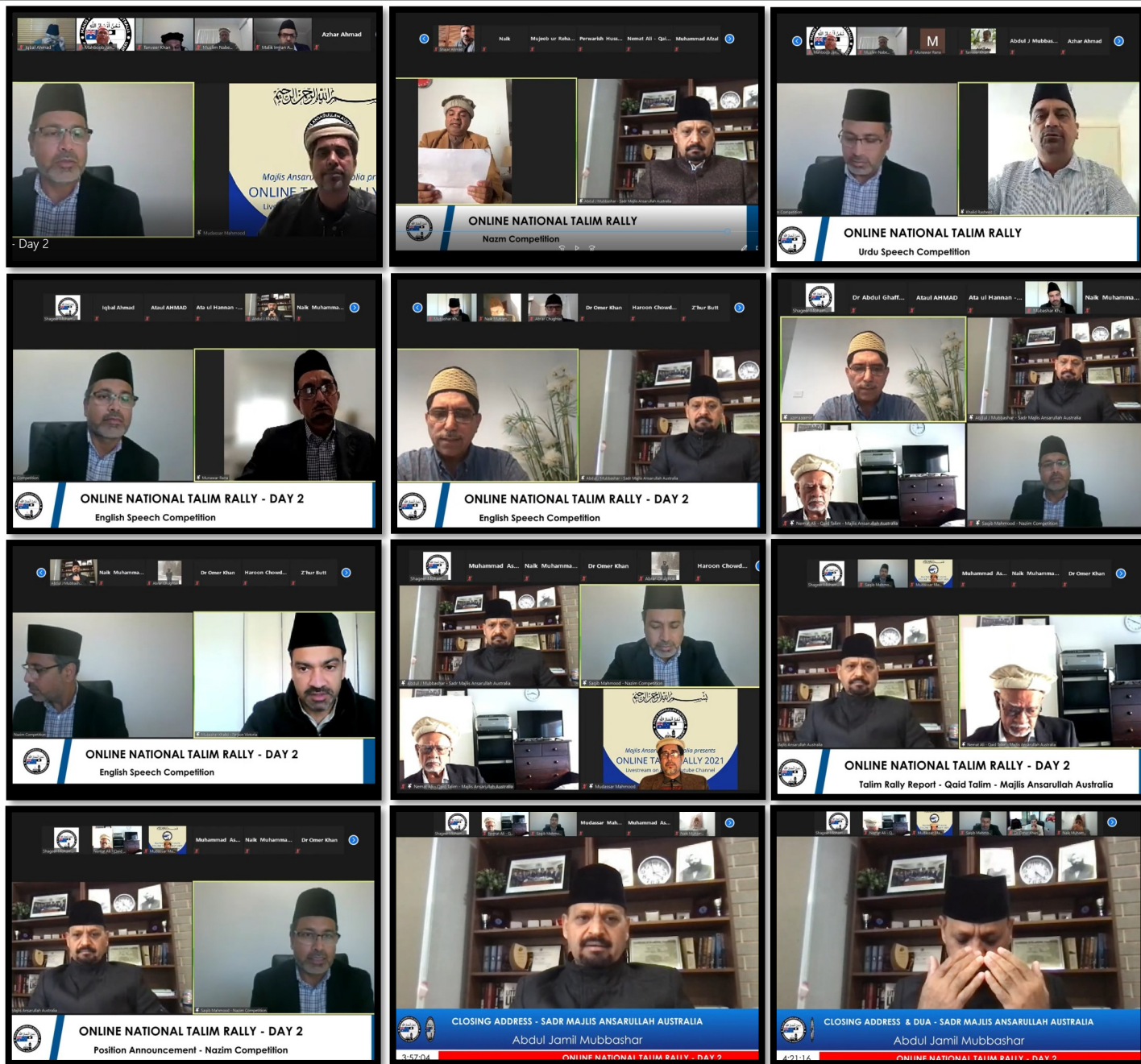

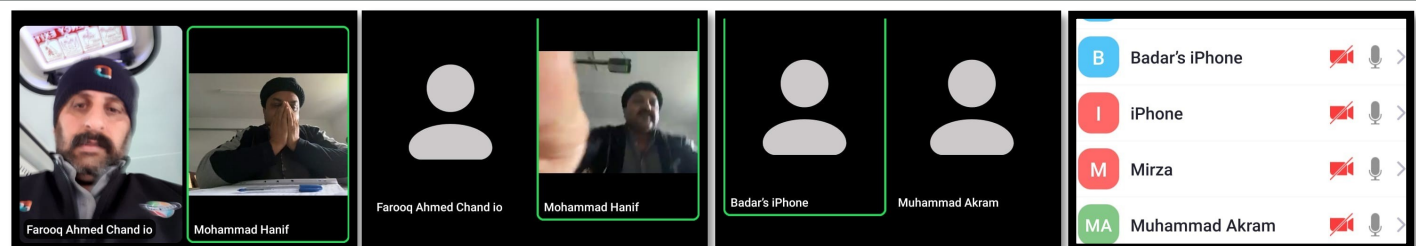

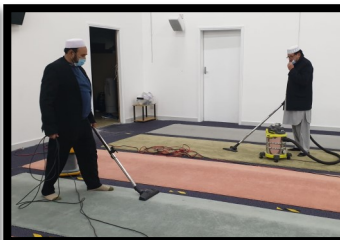
Majlis Ansarullah Australia presents Cheque for \$1,500 to Mater Hospital, Queensland Thursday 20 July 2021

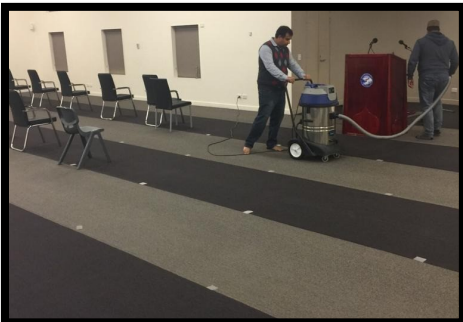

The Promised Messiah (as) said:

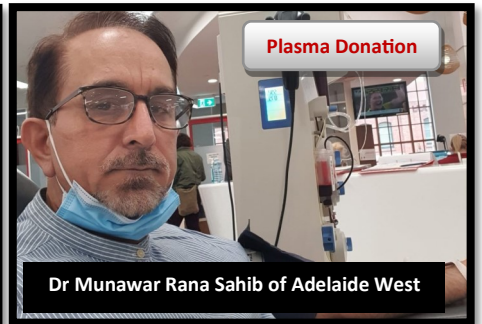
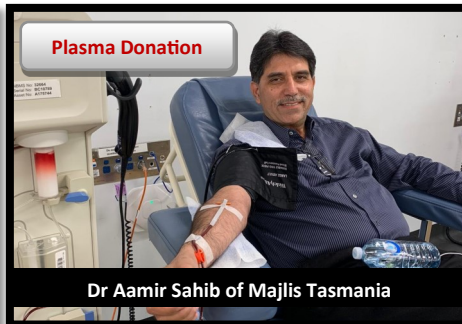
