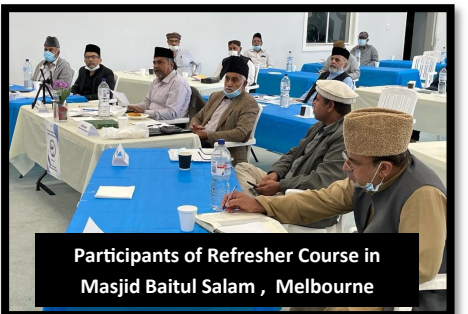

Australia. He migrated to Australia in 2001 from Jhelum Pakistan. His father is one of the martyred Ahmadis of Pakistan. He has been serving Jama'at since his arrival in Australia in different capacities mostly in Multi tasked roles. He was Muhasil & General Secretary, Jama'at Marsden Park and then General Secretary & Naib Sadr, Jama'at Castle Hill. He also served MKA as their Muhtamim Khidmat-e Khalq in National Aamla for 3 years. He joined Ansarullah in 20016 and was included in National Aamla as Qa'id Tarbiyyat initially and then Qa'id Iesaar, the position he continues to serve to date. He is also serving as Acting President, Jama'at Castle Hill.

He is a person of excellence for multi tasking and delivers the quality output with his maturity and hard work.

His father was martyred in Jhelum Pakistan during Anti-Ahmadiyya crisis in 1974. Their shops were plundered and put on fire along with all their belongings in their house.

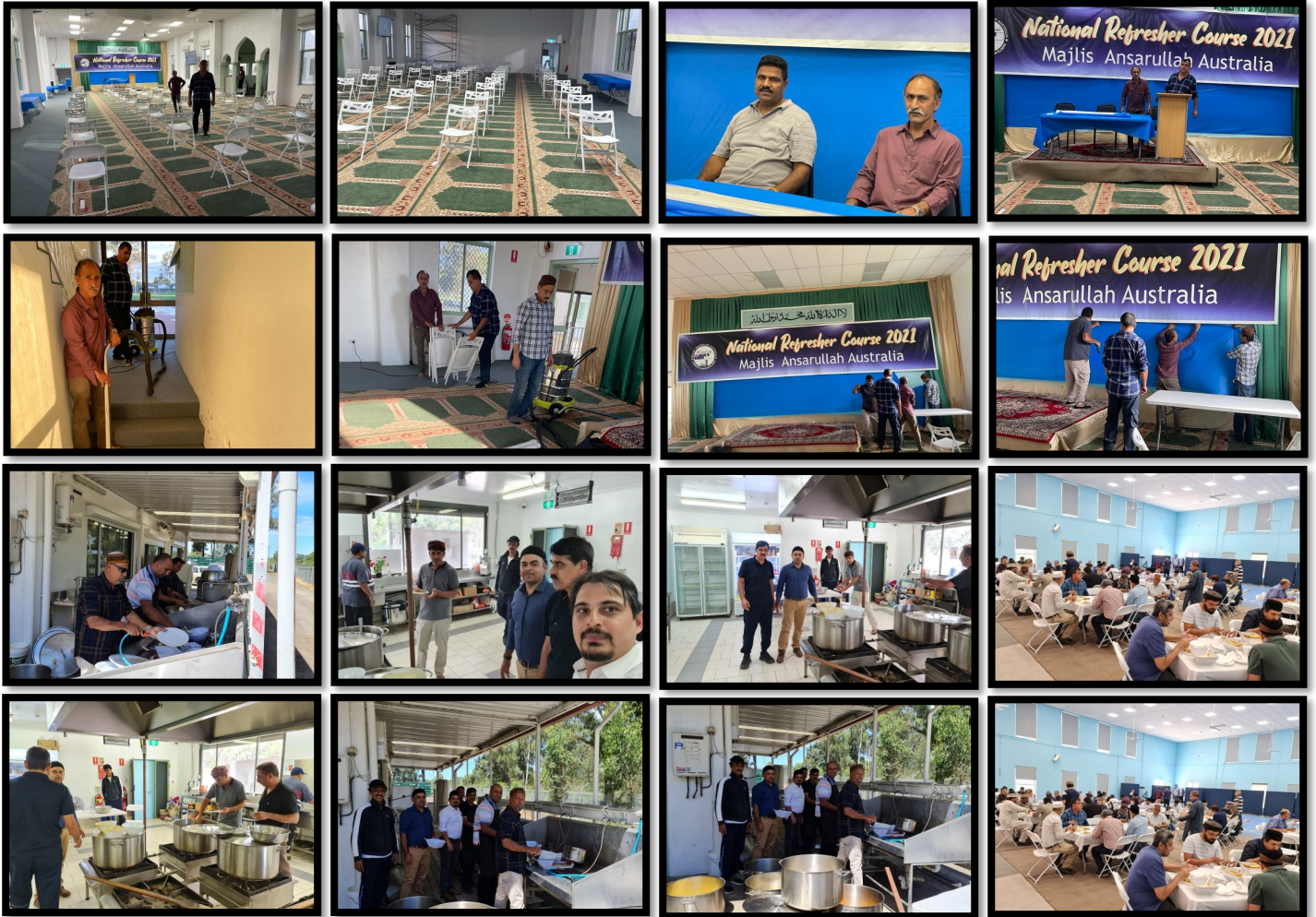
The Promised Messiah (on whom be peace) said:
