Foundation Stone Laying Ceremony of Masjid Baitul Hadi Canberra held on Sunday 21st March, 2021

An impressive Foundation Stone Laying Ceremony for a new Ahmadiyya mosque being built in Canberra was held on Sunday 21st March 2021 from 11 am to 02:00 pm at the mosque site. Over 450 members including 190 Ansar members attended the Ceremony onsite. Over 60 members including Respected Ameer Sahib and Respected Sadr Sahib Majlis Ansarullah laid a brick for the foundation in the Ceremony. The mosque site is more than 4000 square meters, expected to cost about \$4 million to build, will hold space for 300 worshippers and expected to be completed within 15 months.

The Ceremony was livestreamed through YouTube Channel and watched by over 5200 members. Ahmadies around Australia bowed in submission of gratitude to Allah Almighty for his blessings. A few pictures are here, more pictures on page 3.

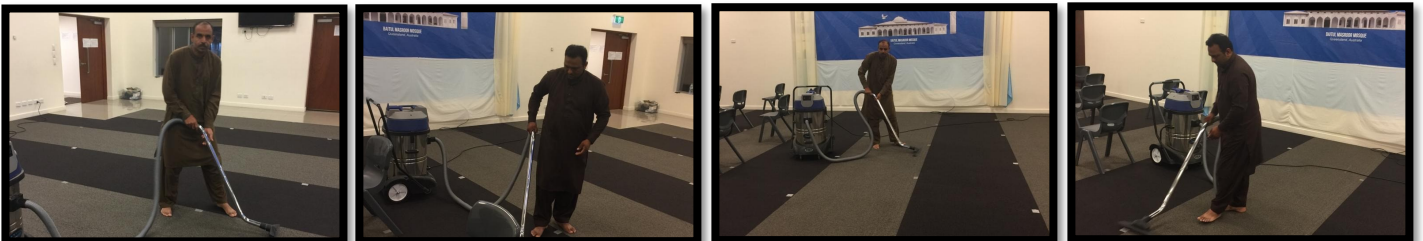

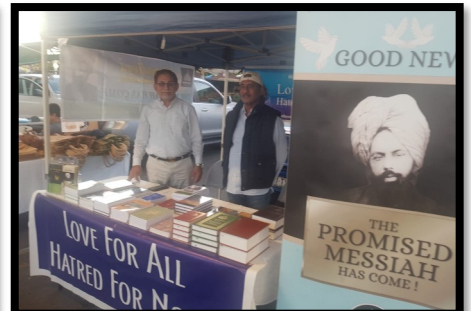
