Majlis Ansarullah NSW held its Holy Quran Seminar on Sunday April 18, 2021 in the Khilfat Hall of Masjid Baitul Huda, Sydney. 150 members from all Majalis of NSW attended the Seminar. Respected Abdul Jamil Mubbashar Sahib, Sadr Majlis Ansarullah Australia chaired the event.

The Seminar started with the recitation from the Holy Quran, followed by Poem. Respected Sadr Sahib highlighted, as an introduction, the blessings of the Holy Quran as the sole objective of the event. Respected Mujeebur Rahman Sanori Sahib, Qa'id Talimul Quran and Waqf-e Aarzi delivered a powerful speech on the blessings of the Holy Quran. 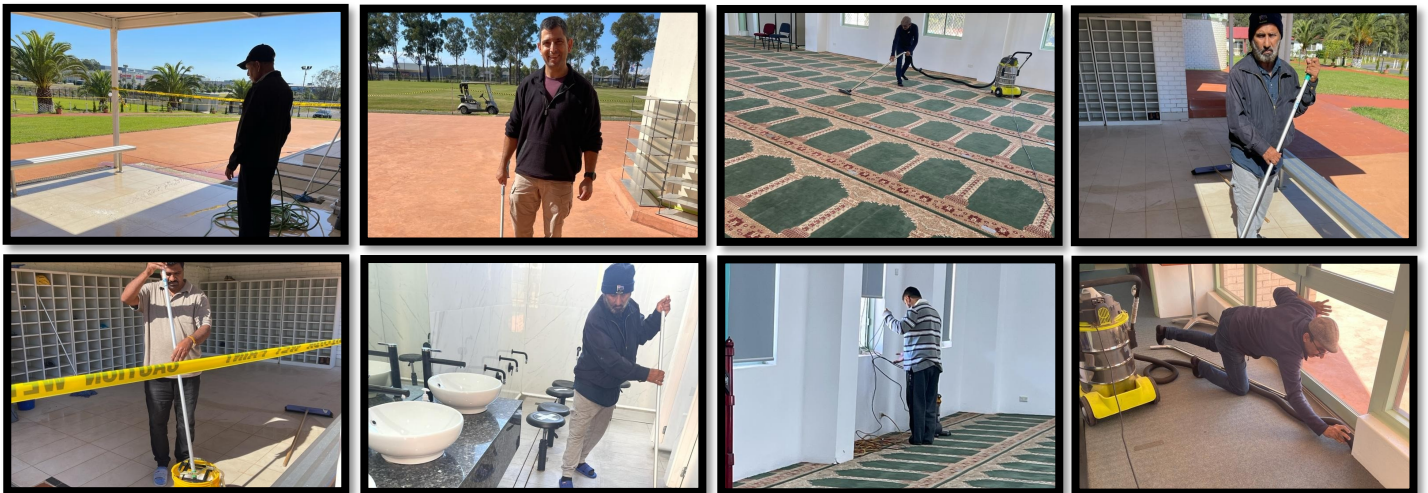
