Saturday 8th May, 2021

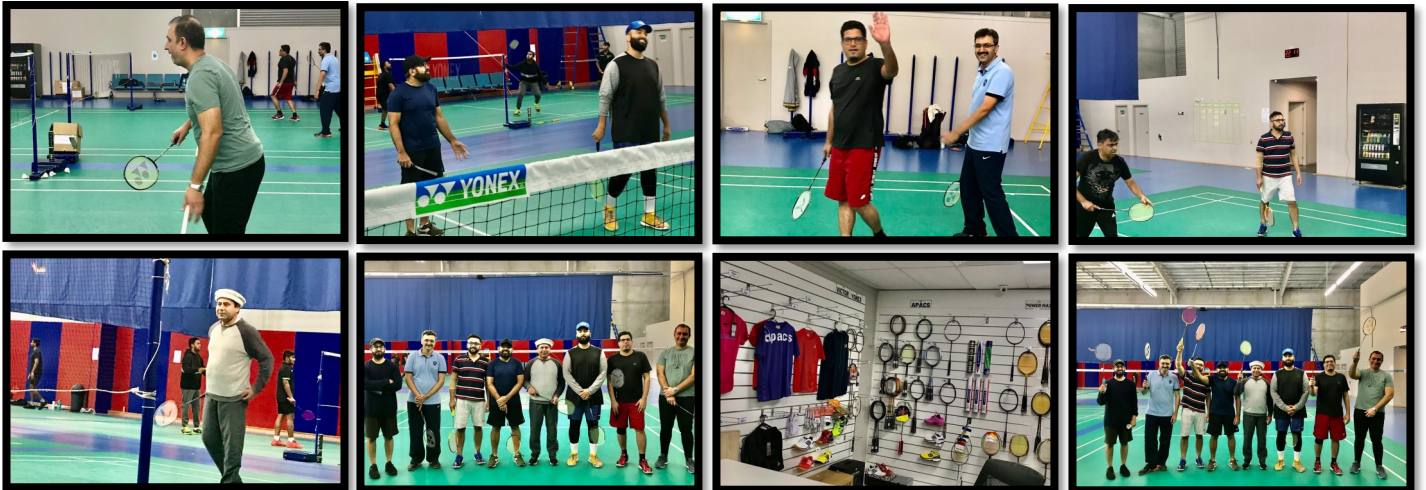

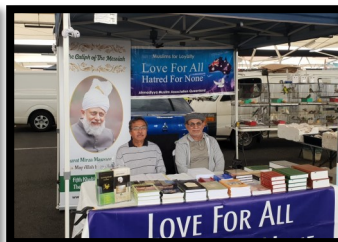
