






Victorian Majalis in Tabligh drive Wednesday 30.06.2021



Department of Talim Talim papers result 2nd Quarter of 2021

The result 2nd quarter (April-June 2021) collected and compiled as of 30 June 2021. Alhamdulillah, 415 papers were received this quarter which is 49% of Tajnid against 44% in the 1st quarter of 2021 and 34% in the 4th quarter of 2020. 6 Majalis achieved 100% of their Tajnid and Zuama of these Majalis deserve special Title as "The Leaders". These are Blacktown, Woodcroft, Morphett Vale, Cranbourne East, Berwick and Tasmania. These Zuama will be presented special appreciation certificates.

In addition to the above, 6 Majalis succeeded to achieve more than 50% participation of their Tajnid and will be provided with Achievement certificates. These Majalis are Adelaide West, Perth, Langwarrin, Logan West, Logan East and Castle Hill. This Quarter, 240 papers were received online while 175 papers were submitted in print.
